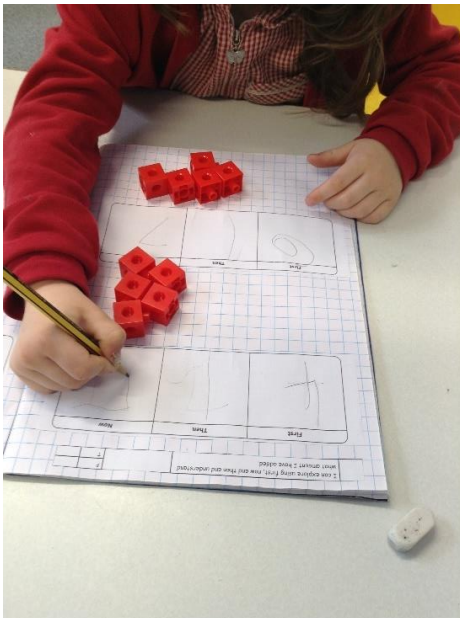
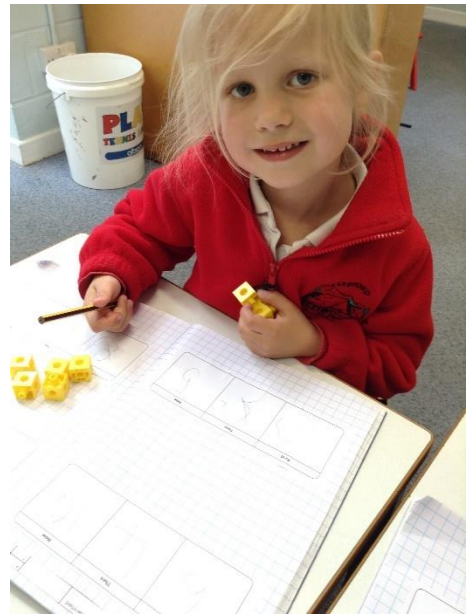
- Apologies to Mrs Brendon as I sent a message out yesterday and changed her gender.

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Construction has proved popular this week in continuous provision!



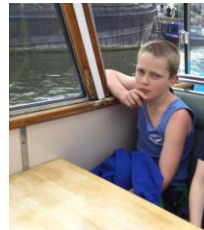
