### Reading

### Maths

Reception: This half term the children will be learning about measure, they will explore different language for example bigger, smaller, taller and shorter. At home you can encourage your child to compare different objects around the house.

Year 1 and 2: Every Monday Yr1 and Yr2 will have maths homework to be completed in their homework book. This can be done independently and is a consolidation of our previous weeks learning, If you would like any resources to support with this at home, please let me know.
