All children are expected to complete the following each week:
Reading: Year 1/2: Children are expected to read 5 x per week with an adult. Parents and carers are required to record the reading by writing in their Reading Records. Please use the questions and prompts at the back of the RWInc book to aide your reading sessions.

EYFS: Enjoy your 'Reading for Pleasure' book with your children throughout the school week, note down in their Reading Records any comments.

Times Tables: Year 1: Please support your child to count different objects in groups of 2.

Year 2: Please help your child practice their 2x, 5x and 10x times tables; they could practice counting, singing songs or using different objects to aide their understanding.

Homework projects: Activities and projects will be set termly. Homework tasks consolidate and practically extend learning taking place in school. Studies have shown that home learning can be extremely important in a child's cognitive development.

The children will get more out of the homework projects if they apply themselves correctly and these are designed to encourage creativity. **Children who rush their projects and do not spend an appropriate time on them will not gain the benefits of our homework policy.** Project homework tasks are for EVERY child to engage in. Choose at least **one** task to complete this half term. **Please bring all homework into school on or before Monday 17th October so that it can be displayed and celebrated during a sharing session on Friday 21st October at 9am to which all parents will be welcome.**

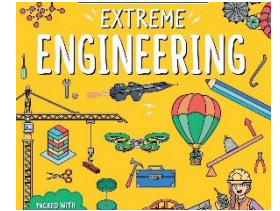
