All children are expected to complete the following each week:

Reading

Reception: Enjoy sharing their reading for pleasure book with them throughout the week, you can record any comments in their reading records. The children also have the RWI sounds they have learnt in their homework books for them to practice. They can do this verbally and in writing.

Year 1/2: are expected to read 5 x per week with an adult. Please record your child's reading in their reading records.

Spelling

Year 1/2 will have a set of spellings to practice each week.

Maths

Reception: This half term the children will be learning about length and height. Please encourage your child to explore everyday objects using the language, taller, shorter, longer, tallest and shortest.

Year 1 and 2: Every Monday Yr1 and Yr2 will have maths homework to be completed in their homework book. This can be done independently and is a consolidation of our previous weeks learning, If you would like any resources to support with this at home, please let me know.
