




<p><b>Class 2 HOMEWORK Spring Term 2 2025</b></p> <p>All children are expected to complete the following each week:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Spelling- Children will be taught statutory spellings and will have a list of words to learn each week. On Friday week one they will be tested on the list, on Friday week two they will be tested on the spellings through paragraph dictation.</li> <li>2. Times tables – Year 3 children are expected to learn their 2,3,4,5,8 and 10 times tables, Year 4,5 and 6 up to 12 x 12. Maths weekly homework sheets to be brought in on Monday.</li> <li>3. TTRS aim for 10 minutes, 3 times a week</li> <li>4. Reading – Children are expected to read 5 x per week with an adult.
