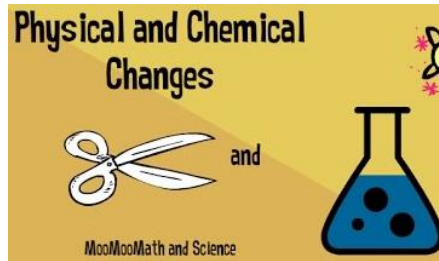


Art/DT

We are learning about states of matter and physical and chemical changes.

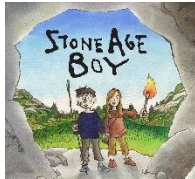
History
