It is an entitlement to all children as part of the National Curriculum requirements for Science (Life Processes and Living things), P.S.H.E (Personal, Social, Health Education) and R.S.E. (Relationships and Sex Education). Teaching and learning recognises that sexual development is a natural part of growing up and fosters individual wellbeing.

Our policy states –


Parents do not have the right to withdraw their children from relationships education.
