Addendum to the Behaviour Policy regarding Covid - 19

To ensure children, staff and communities are kept as safe as possible during the Covid-19 pandemic, we have added a number of additions to the behaviour policy:

- All children and adults must follow any altered routines for arrival or departure following school instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitising.
- All children and adults should follow instructions on who children can socialise with at school moving around the school as per specific instructions (for example, one-way systems, out of bounds areas, queuing) expectations about sneezing, coughing, tissues, and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoiding touching the mouth, nose, and eyes with hands.
- All children and adults should tell a member of staff as soon as possible if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus.
- All children and adults to follow rules about not sharing any equipment or other items including drinking bottles
- All children and adults should follow amended expectations and rules about breaks or play times, including where children may or may not play, use of toilets, clear rules about coughing or spitting at or towards any other person
- There are clear expectations for children at home about conduct in relation to remote education
- The school's rewards and sanction system has been adapted to focus on any additional rules
- Possible additional reasonable adjustments will be identified and included for children with more challenging behaviour
