Physical Education

This will be taught every Monday and Wednesday. The children's PE kit and trainers can stay in school all week.

<u>Homework</u>

Homework grids will be given out at the start of each term and the Homework Share will take place during the last week of term.

<u>Reading</u>

Please read with your child everyday and record it in their Reading Record.

Forest School.

Mrs Waddington teaches the children for Forest School every Friday afternoon. They will need coats, waterproof trousers and wellington boots.

The children's wellies can stay in school all week so that they can enjoy the many outdoor learning opportunities.

What will my child be learning this term?

<u>Maths</u>

This term we will be focussing on Place Value, understanding the importance of counting correctly and developing our understanding of numbers.

<u>Phonics</u>

This term we have been placed in new Phonics groups. We will be reading lots of different books and then working through our Get Writing Phonics books. We also have an exciting new Reading Corner in which we can explore lots of different fiction and non-fiction books.

<u>Science</u>

The children will be exploring Light. This includes exploring what light is, different light sources and how we see different objects.

<u>History</u>

We will be learning all about different Scientists and Engineers. We will explore the life and important work of: George Stephenson, Isambard Kingdom Brunel, Marie Curie, Mary Anning, Mary Seacole and Stephen Hawking.

<u>Religious Education</u> This term we will be exploring the religion of Islam. Including what Muslims believe and some of their important celebrations.











Relationship and Health Education

Within these lessons we will be exploring being at school within our classroom with our school friends.

<u>Music</u>

In our Music lessons we will be exploring different songs, ways of using our voices as well as enjoying singing lots of new songs!

<u>Art</u>

This term our Art lessons will explore sketching and drawing in different ways. We will be focussing on different minibeasts, including the different and very intricate patterns they display.
