

Free School Meals

FSM - Your child may be entitled to free school meals (FSM). You can find out more information on free school meals and how to apply here: https://www.devon.gov.uk/educationandfamilies/school-information/school-meals

UIFSM – All pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are eligible for Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM). Parents/ carers do not need to apply for UIFSM but **can apply for FSM whilst their child is in Class** 1. This will bring in extra pupil premium funding for your child should you be eligible which can be used for extra resources and subsidizing things like swimming and the wider curriculum.

Cool Milk

Our school provides a milk scheme that is available to all pupils. School milk is free for under-5s and reception pupils have already been registered.

Each child that registers with Cool Milk will receive a 189ml portion of semi-skimmed milk every day, delivered fresh and chilled to the classroom.

How to register -If your child is five or older:

- Register and pay online at <u>www.coolmilk.com</u>
- Alternatively, fill in a registration form available from the school office once Cool Milk has
 processed your form, you will receive a payment request
- You can pay Cool Milk either online, over the phone or at a local Pay Point in half-termly, termly or annual instalments.
- Please pay by a Tuesday at 5pm for your child's milk to start the following week
