Good morning,

From today, Government guidance on Covid testing has changed.  
Anyone testing positive on an LFT test without symptoms no longer needs a PCR test.  
Anyone who has one of the three main Covid-19 symptoms, a dry persistent cough, a high temperature or loss of taste or smell, should still complete a PCR test.

A reminder that the isolation period is now 7 days subject to two consecutive negative LFT tests, 24 hours apart no sooner than day 6 and 7 of isolation. If LFTs remain positive, isolation can end after 10 days as before.

We currently have no cases of Covid-19 in children or staff.

Our protective measures remain in place including:

Enhanced cleaning

Ventilation

Face coverings in communal spaces for adults

Essential visitors only.
